

COAVER VOLLEYBALL CLUB (CVC) – SUMMER LEAGUE 2026

Welcome to Coaver volleyball, it's good to get everyone back for a new season!

Team entry - Teams have been allocated to a division largely based on preference. However, promotion and relegation will take place during the season where appropriate. Entry fees can be paid direct into the Club bank account or should be paid in person prior to playing.

Registered teams / players - All players must register in advance of playing. This enables temporary membership for non-members (visiting teams). Details should be emailed to martin.oram123@gmail.com. New players can be registered during the season, except on finals night. Players can apply for Club membership at a cost of £37.20 per annum (spouse membership is then free) <https://www.coaverclub.com/membership>.

Parking – due to DCC parking restrictions, Coaver Club members may access the Coaver car park via the barriers by registering their car reg with the Coaver Club. Non-members can park in the visitors Car park in front of County Hall main entrance. Parking is free in the evenings.

Court Layout – when setting up, allow space for Junior courts around the cricket wicket

Playing times – Teams can arrive from 4.30pm. You can set up a net/practice & access the club. League matches start at 6pm. Matches are timed & Club officials will indicate start/end times.

Playing format – matches are 4v4. Normal volleyball rules apply. No limit on substitutions. Time - outs are not permitted. When the final hooter sounds, any point in play must be completed. Players may play up to help other teams, **but playing down is not permitted**.

Fixtures lists and league structure will be available on the night and/or facebook. Club officials will post a photo of the final scoresheet on facebook immediately following the fixtures.

Net rota – this sets out each team's duties in setting up nets. If you havnt done it before, learn from other teams. Note your duties & arrive early to set up. The last teams playing on any court must pack away & return to the storage unit in the Club. Don't leave kit on the lawn/patio.

Alcohol – teams bringing their own alcohol on site will be banned from the league forthwith.

Juniors – junior sessions will run alongside the summer league this season, so please take care when in and around the junior courts and always set a good example to juniors.

Weekend tournament – Saturday 18 July, register 12.30, matches 1pm to 5.30pm (Free Entry)

Annual BBQ – Thursday 3 September 2026. This is our final match night.

Insurance - As in previous years, Insurance cover is **NOT** provided by Devon County Council, Coaver Club or Coaver Volleyball Club. Those participating do so at their own risk and should make their own insurance cover arrangements as necessary.

Fines – will be applied for teams failing to comply with the net rota (£10) and teams failing to turn up without having given 24hrs notice (£10).
